State Noxious Weed Control Board sets public hearing to consider changes to the 2025 noxious weed list and WAC 16.750

The changes proposed consist of two class A additions, one Class B designation changes, one class C addition, and pronoun updates.

WAC 16-750-011 Class B Noxious Weed Changes and Additions

Un-designating shiny geranium, Geranium lucidum, in Pierce County.

WAC 16-750-015 Class C Noxious Weed Changes and Additions

Adding wild holly, *llex species* not including holly found in managed landscapes, or where commercially or agriculturally grown.

Updating Pronouns Throughout

WAC 16-750-120 (8)(11), WAC 16-750-130 (2b), WAC 16-750-135 (11)(15c), WAC 16-750-137 (5).
